Improving Facilities and Access ~

The Sutter Health network of physicians and not-for-profit hospitals will invest billions of dollars over ten years to rebuild, replace and expand much of Northern California's health care infrastructure. Locally, plans (or completed projects) include:

- **Sutter Surgical Hospital**—North Valley: Broke ground on a \$34 million, 14-bed surgical hospital. The collaborative partnership between Sutter North Medical Foundation, National Surgical Hospitals and community physicians will open in 2008.

Sampling of Community Partnerships/Programs ~

In 2006, Sutter North Medical Foundation provided \$4.4 million in support of charity care and various community programs and services such as:

- **Health Education Access Library**—a community resource providing access to a wealth of health information at no charge. The library includes diabetes monitoring software system.
- **Business & Community Health Partnership**—a collaborative partnership formed by Sutter North Medical Foundation to bring business together to help make a difference in the health of the community.
- **Crossroads**—a breast cancer support group offering breast cancer patients and their family/friends opportunities to come together for mutual support during the on-going recovery process.
- **TATS Off Program**—A tattoo removal program helping people with tattoos eliminate the stigma associated with their former lifestyles.

Advancing Patient Safety ~

Sutter North Medical Foundation and our Sutter Health network are raising the bar on patient safety. We are the first network on the West Coast to use early warning software as well as advanced video and electronic monitoring to allow physician specialists to keep an even closer eye on critically ill patients 24 hours a day, seven days a week. We continue to be a pioneer in using bar-coding and expert databases to track medication orders to help prevent errors. To further improve clinical outcomes, enhance patient safety and reduce the cost of high-quality care, Sutter Health also is investing \$450 million to deploy an electronic health record (EHR) system as well as \$1.2 billion in a broad range of patient safety initiatives over the next 10 years.
