Sutter Regional Medical Foundation (SRMF) is affiliated with two multi-specialty medical group practices: Solano Regional Medical Group (SRMG) in Solano County and Sutter Delta Medical Group (SDMG) in East Contra Costa County.

SRMG is the only group practice in Solano County fully accredited by the Institute for Medical Quality. Through SRMG, more than 60 physicians and allied health practitioners provide care for patients in Fairfield, Vacaville, Vallejo, and Rio Vista.

SDMG forms the core of a growing network of nearly 100 physicians that serve the residents of East Contra Costa. SDMG provides care for patients in Antioch, Brentwood, and Pittsburg.

SRMF operates Sutter Fairfield Medical Campus, an 80,000 square foot state-of-the-art health care center that features outpatient surgery, diagnostic imaging, and medical offices.

The Sutter Health network of physicians and not-for-profit hospitals will invest billions of dollars over ten years to rebuild, replace and expand much of Northern California's health care infrastructure.

Advancing Patient Safety ~

Sutter Regional Medical Foundation and our Sutter Health network are raising the bar on patient safety. We are the first network on the West Coast to use early warning software as well as advanced video and electronic monitoring to allow physician specialists to keep an even closer eye on critically ill patients 24 hours a day, seven days a week. We continue to be a pioneer in using bar-coding and expert databases to track medication orders to help prevent errors. To further improve clinical outcomes, enhance patient safety and reduce the cost of high-quality care, Sutter Health also is investing \$450 million to deploy an electronic health record (EHR) system as well as \$1.2 billion in a broad range of patient safety initiatives over the next 10 years.
